My goddaughter Sue was kind to me during my battle with cancer. I wrote a short piano piece for her as her birthday present. She requested I should write in "Classical" style, like music of the Mozart/Haydn era. When I wrote this piece I was thinking more of Handel. Sue was delighted with the piece and I taught her to play it. On my birthday, Sue treated me to the Chelsea Flower Show. Then Sue was diagnosed with cancer. She refused treatment but relied on prayers, saying God's all mighty and would save her. I tried to reason with her but she refused to see me. Sue then created a website advocating the healing power of God and Christian priests. I have not heard from her since.

During COVID lockdown, Julian Jacobson, concert pianist and a professor at the Royal College of Music, recorded this piece at home for me. I then came across Herry Lawford's photos of the Chelsea Flower Show. He kindly let me modify his photos to make this music video and he was delighted with the result. Herry told me his interest in the moral of the Fox and the Little Prince, and his devotion to his Japanese wife. I told him I like the bust of himself that he commissioned. When I contacted him about this HK-Wickford Display, sadly, I found that he had passed away.
